How November Got its Name

November got its name from the Latin "novembris mensis," meaning "ninth month." Plutarch, a first-century Greek biographer and historian, attributed the change to the eleventh month to Numa Pompilius, a Roman king. "Many will say that it was Numa who added the two months of Januarius and Februarius, for in the beginning they had a year of ten months." Numa supposedly also shortened November to 29 days; Julius Caesar returned it to 30 days.
