The winners will be posted at the restaurants. At the date of this publication, we still had a few days left for people to guess. Thank-you to everyone who played the guessing game.

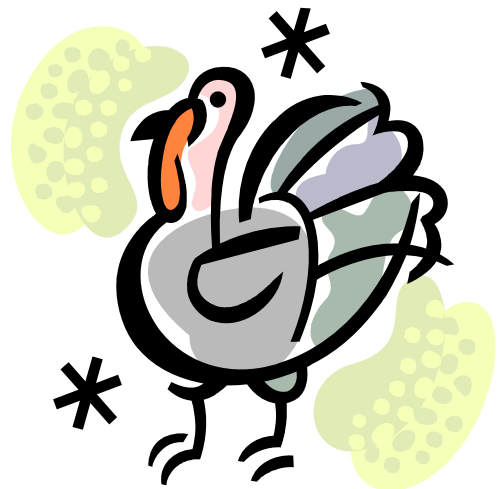
Free Dessert For Military Personnel

A Myth About Thanksgiving ~ The Pilgrims Ate Turkey.....

What did the Pilgrims eat at their Thanksgiving festival? They didn't have corn on the cob, apples, pears, potatoes or even cranberries. No one knows if they had turkey, although they were used to eating turkey. The only food we know they had for sure was deer. (and they didn't eat with a fork; they didn't have forks back then.)

So how did we get the idea that you have turkey and cranberry and such on Thanksgiving? It was because the Victorians prepared Thanksgiving that way. And they're the ones who made Thanksgiving a national holiday, beginning in 1863, when Abe Lincoln issued his presidential Thanksgiving proclamations...two of them: one to celebrate Thanksgiving in August, a second one in November. Before Lincoln Americans outside New England did not usually celebrate the holiday. The Pilgrims, incidentally, didn't become part of the holiday until late in the nineteenth century.
