The first Labor Day in the United States was observed on Tuesday, September 5, 1882, in New York City. The Central Labor Union in New York initiated the event to honor the contributions made by workers to the strength and prosperity of the country. Events included a street parade and a festival to entertain workers and their families. The celebration was repeated the following year, and as labor unions expanded, many industrial cities began to observe the holiday. In 1887, Oregon became the first state to officially adopt Labor Day; and by 1894, most of the other states had followed suit. That year, Congress passed an act making the first Monday in September a legal holiday. Today, speeches are standard in official programs, along with parades, music, street festivals, and even a hot-air balloon festival in Atlanta. For many, the holiday has become a "good-bye" to summer, and picnics and cook-outs are a regular part of the long weekend.

'Thinking' your way to fitness

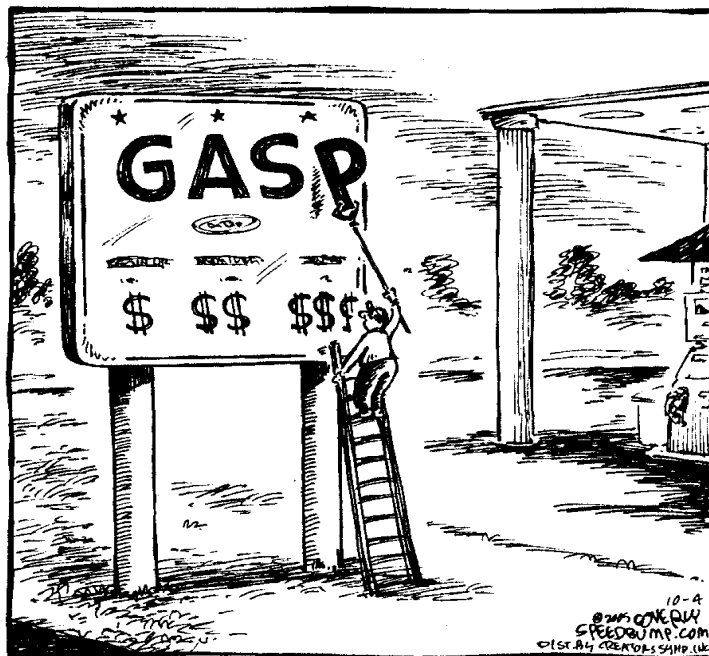
If you're out of shape and at risk for a serious health problem because of it, a new study has found that *how* you think about your health is key to a healthy lifestyle.

The study looked at people who said they either didn't exercise, or exercised inconsistently. The researchers asked some of the participants to list "reasons" they should increase their levels of exercise and cardiovascular fitness. Other participants were asked to list "actions" they could take to increase their exercise fitness, like joining a gym or working out with someone they knew. The researchers found that after eight weeks, the participants who were asked to think of actions increased their exercise, while those who were asked to merely list reasons to exercise made no improvement. Motivating yourself to better health may be easier, say the researchers, if you think of what you could be doing rather than why you should be doing it. The results were originally published in the *Journal of Applied Behavioral Research*.
